a. Chair Elaine F

- LSC election period opened January 3rd. Applications. Local School Council. [Local School Councils \(LSCs\) | Chicago Public Schools \(cps.edu\)](#)
Multiple spots open, including community and teacher LSC positions

b. Principal Report:

- i. Update on soft opening of school Mon 10-Jan:
 - 1) 99 students came to school today. Majority were 5th grade and younger. 20+ staff members. Activities in gym and meals offered.
 - 2) No new curriculum introduced.
 - 3) We are one of six schools in Network One that offered the option
- ii. Biggest factors in stoppage:
 - 1) Testing %s: we have 150 of 640 students enrolled in testing (23%!). However, the test provider has limited capacity and is not able to test this group. Important to increase enrollment and to increase resources for testing
 - 2) Masks: K95 masks delivered for all staff members. And available to students by end of week.
 - 3) Health screener: May be reintroduced depending on CTU and CPS negotiations
 - 4) Vaccinations: 40+% are fully vaccinated at Sauganash and # is increasing
 - 5) Cases: count is low (single digits for 2022). As a precaution, the close is flipped remote for non-vaccinated children and this has been very effective in stopping outbreaks
