

IMMUNIZATION/EXAM GUIDE FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2015-2016

- Find your child's age/grade level below and read across to the right
- Each checkmark (✓) represents one required vaccine
- Your child only needs as many vaccines that are shown at each grade level. For example, if there are three Hepatitis B vaccines listed next to 6th grade, and your 6th grade child already received 3 doses before preschool, they are medically compliant and do not need 3 more doses at 6th grade.

REQUIRED EXAMS DUE BY OCTOBER 15, 2015

Physical Exam requirements due by <u>October 15, 2015</u>:	Any new incoming to CPS from out of state or out of country	Preschool and Kindergarten	6 th and 9 th grade students (ages 5, 11, 15 for ungraded programs)
Vision Exam requirements due for the following students by <u>October 15, 2015</u>	Any new incoming to CPS from out of state or out of country	Kindergarten	
Dental Exam requirements due for the following students by <u>May 15, 2016</u>:		Kindergarten	2 nd and 6 th grade students (ages 5, 7, 11 for ungraded programs)

Any student entering CPS for the first time must provide all previous health records, if not entering at a grade that requires new exams or immunizations.
