

## Talking points

- Reduce overcrowding:
  - As of September 2019 = 123% capacity
  - 664 students; +36 students = 6% increase from last year, FY17-FY19: +4% each year
  - Safety issues with MTSS learning in hallways and stairway landings
  
- Increase 8 classes to support 3 classes per grade level
  - Need to support Special Education IEP requirements (age span, pull out minutes, and testing space requirements)
  - Music Room, music is now on a cart visiting homerooms
  - Music equipment purchased now can't be used because of space and traveling with large instruments is too difficult being on the cart.
  - Preschool classes on our campus for safety and providing options to take advantage of meeting the new Advance Placement Act. (4 year olds can apply for kindergarten, our neighborhood could have high numbers in the future)
  
- Focus on rebuilding Gymnasium to increase size
  - Gym is not big enough to house large class size for gym class
  - Sport Games can't fit teammates
  - No space for a parent audience
  
  - Plus we have a leaky roof which is unpleasant and poses another safety issue.
