The Sauganash Elementary School administration and the 6th Grade team would like to provide parents with a snapshot of “A Day as a Sauganash 6th Grader.”

Language Arts Instruction with Mrs. Evans

The language arts curriculum is designed to help students increase their communication and analytical skills. Students will be reading and responding to a variety of engaging literature and informational text. Their grammar and vocabulary skills will be enhanced through both online and workbook activities. Instruction will be a combination of the whole class and small group to meet the needs of all learners. For technology, students will be using Scope Scholastic, CommonLit, and Freckle to strengthen their reading skills.

Writing and Social Studies Instruction with Mr. Allore

During this course we will be exploring how we can use writing to express our thoughts and ideas. Students will apply a global perspective to explore our world and its people beginning with ancient civilizations. We will study through the lenses of geography, history, government, economics, and culture to examine the different aspects of how people live. Writing genres will include informative/explanatory, argumentative, and narrative. There will be daily opportunities for students to write in both free and prompted manners, with ample time to improve upon their initial drafts. Writing in class will be a mixture of handwritten work and tasks that utilize technology.

Math Instruction with Mrs. Ozga

Students in sixth grade will have daily Warm Up practice problems for the first ten minutes of class. Whole group instruction and small group direct instruction will be utilized for each topic. Students will be using the enVision math book for daily vocabulary building and practice. For each topic, students will work together on a variety of higher order thinking math problems in cooperative learning groups. Our classroom is equipped with a SmartBoard, white boards and a Webcam. For online practice and enrichment, students will be using Freckle, Khan Academy, Virtual Nerd, and Savvas Realize to strengthen their math skills.

Science Instruction with Ms. Kroeger

This year we will be using hands-on labs, simulations, and real world phenomena to explore the world around us! Our journey will take us on explorations of the following topics:

- Ecosystems and Matter Cycling
- Plate Tectonics
- Natural Disasters
- Properties of Matter

Special Education Instruction with Mrs. Knorr

Students will learn in both small group and co-taught environments based on specific academic and functional goals as written in their Individualized Education Plans. The main objective is to encourage students to utilize their strengths and preferred learning modalities to develop and refine basic and critical thinking skills, while emphasizing social emotional well-being. Students learn strategies that allow access to and achievement within Common Core State Standards.
