2014-2015 Minimum Health Requirements for Chicago Public Schools

The Chicago Board of Education recognizes the relationship between academic achievement and healthy students. The following health requirements apply to all children enrolled in a Chicago Public School. Children must provide proof of required immunizations and health exams before <u>October 15, 2014</u>, or they will face exclusion from school.

EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS

<u>Physical Examination</u> requirements due upon enrollment, <u>no later than 10/15/14</u> Physical Examination must be completed within one year prior to entry to:

- Preschool and kindergarten (physical exam and lead screening through age 6)
 - 6th grade and 9th grade (ages 5, 11, 15 for un-graded programs)
 - Any student entering CPS for the first time, must show proof of exam; students transferring from another state or country must complete an exam within one year prior to entry

Vision Examination requirements due upon enrollment, no later than 10/15/14

- Entering the State of Illinois for the first time at any grade level
- Entering kindergarten

Dental Examination requirements due upon enrollment, no later than 5/15/15

· Entering kindergarten, 2nd grade, and 6th grade

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

Diphtheria, Pertussis (Whooping Cough), Tetanus (DTaP/Tdap)

- Four (4) or more doses for preschool, kindergarten, or 1st grade; three (3) or more doses for all other grades
- The last dose qualifying as a booster and received on or after the 4th birthday
- One dose of the Tdap vaccine for students 6th through 12th grades

<u>Polio</u>

- Three (3) or more doses of a polio vaccine before entering school at any grade if inactivated vaccine used, exclusively. Four (4) doses are required at any grade if inactivated and oral polio vaccine are given in combination.
- · The last dose qualifying as a booster and received on or after the 4th birthday

Measles, Mumps, and Rubella

- One (1) dose required for preschool, and two (2) doses required before entering any other grade
- 1st dose received at 12 months or later
- 2nd dose must be administered at least four weeks (28 days) after 1st dose

<u>Hepatitis</u>

- · Three (3) doses required before entering preschool and 6th grade
- 2nd dose received at least 4 weeks after 1st dose
- 3rd dose received at least 2 months after 2nd dose, and 4 months after 1st dose (must be on or after 6 months of age)

Varicella (Chicken Pox)

- NEW Beginning with school year 2014-2015, any child entering kindergarten, 6th grade, or 9th grade for the first time shall show proof of having received two (2) doses of varicella vaccine, the first dose on or after the first birthday and the second dose no less than four weeks (28 days) after the first dose.
- One (1) dose required on or after the first birthday for all other grades

Haemophilus Influenzae, Type B (HIB)

- One (1) or more doses required for students entering any preschool or pre-kindergarten program (not required for children 5 years of age or older)
- One (1) dose required if first dose administered at or after 15 months of age

Pneumococcal Disease (PCV)

 One (1) or more doses required for students entering any preschool or pre-kindergarten program (not required for children 5 years of age or older)

FAST-TRACK IMMUNIZATION CLINICS

The Chicago Department of Public Health (CDHP) Fast Track immunization clinics provide vaccination at no charge for children 0 through 18 years of age.

They also provide flu vaccinations at no charge for adults of all ages and all children over age six months.

No appointment is necessary; vaccinations are given on a first come, first served basis.
