An Update from us on COVID-19 Testing

Testing through the ReadyCheckGo Testing Program will begin this week for all students that opted in. Our testing stay as of now is Monday's.

Submitting Vaccine Cards & Covid Testing Registration

We will start collecting and logging vaccine cards for eligible students that received the full dose(s) of the vaccine. CPS nurses will be inputting the information in each child's ASPEN profile. If you



child is fully vaccinated this will help with potential close contact tracing, quarantining, sports, etc. If you are interested in submitting this for your child (12 years +) you can bring it to school for us to make a copy of the card. Athletics Update:

The district will begin enforcing this requirement to submit proof of vaccination (for those eligible) or participate in weekly COVID-19 testing on *September 20, 2021 for all high school sports*, and *September 30, 2021 for all elementary school sports*. Dear Sauganash Parent/Guardian,

Welcome back to an exciting and promising school year! As part of the district's efforts to ensure the safety of our students, we are partnering with Thermo Fisher Scientific and Color Health to provide all students with COVID-19 testing beginning September 1, 2021 for the school year through the ReadyCheckGo™ testing program.

If you are interested in having your child participate in testing, please follow this link <https://home.color.com/covid/sign-up/start?partner=tf-sau-610155-students> and complete the registration process. A parent or guardian must register any minor under 18 years old, and you'll give a one-time consent and HIPAA authorization to share your child's results with the school and district.

Testing is optional for students, except for unvaccinated and partially vaccinated student athletes. Testing will take place during regular school hours and results will be available in 24 to 48 hours. Color Health will follow up with you directly if your child receives a positive result.
