Fill out the form completely
All family members **must** be listed in part 1
Form **must** include the address in part 6
Form **must** be signed
This # is **not** the # on the medical card. If you do not know your case number please call your case worker.

Much like attendance, the CPS Grading Policy is the same as if we were in the school building. I encourage parents to utilize ASPEN Portal (1st-8th only) to view your students grades. School-wide each class has a participation category that is worth 50% of the student's grade so it is important they are following their class schedule and participating in their various classes.
